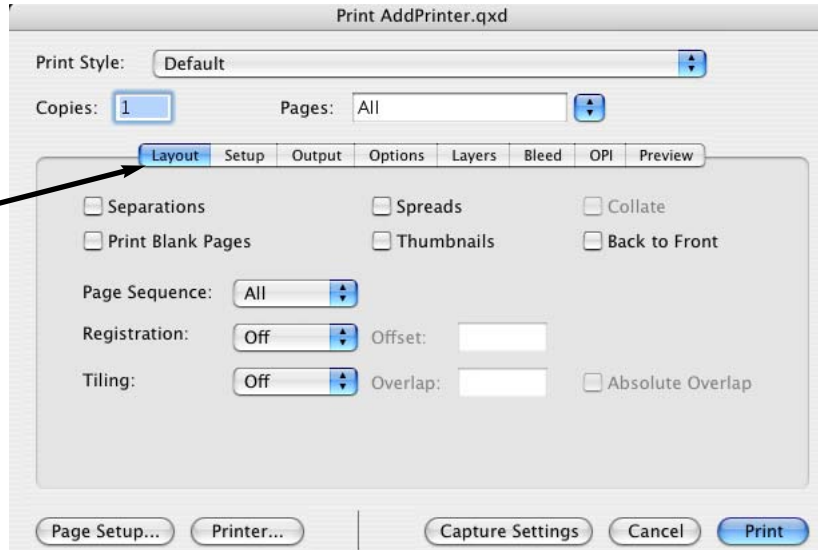


# Printer Settings in Quark 6 in OS X

Follow these directions to Print a Postscript file in Quark 6 on a Macintosh running OS X

When you have completed your job, click on "File" then "Print".

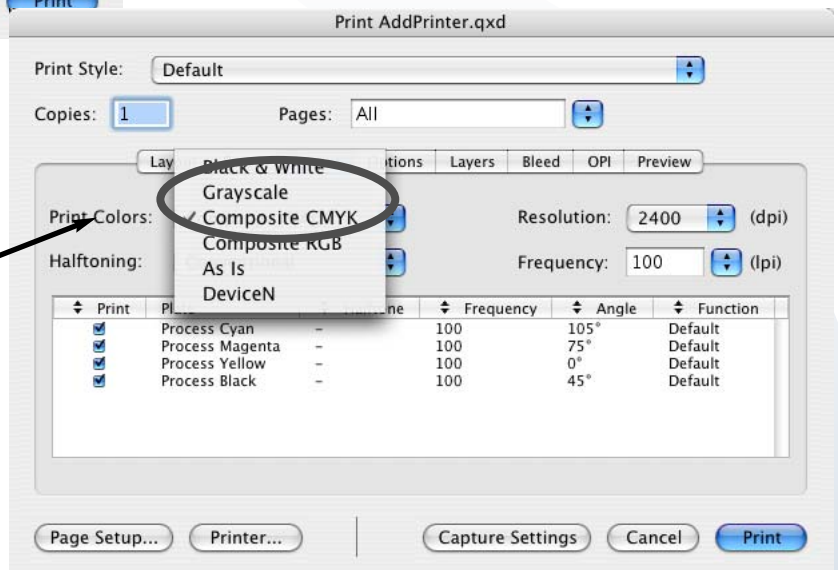
1. The "Layout" tab should look as follows.

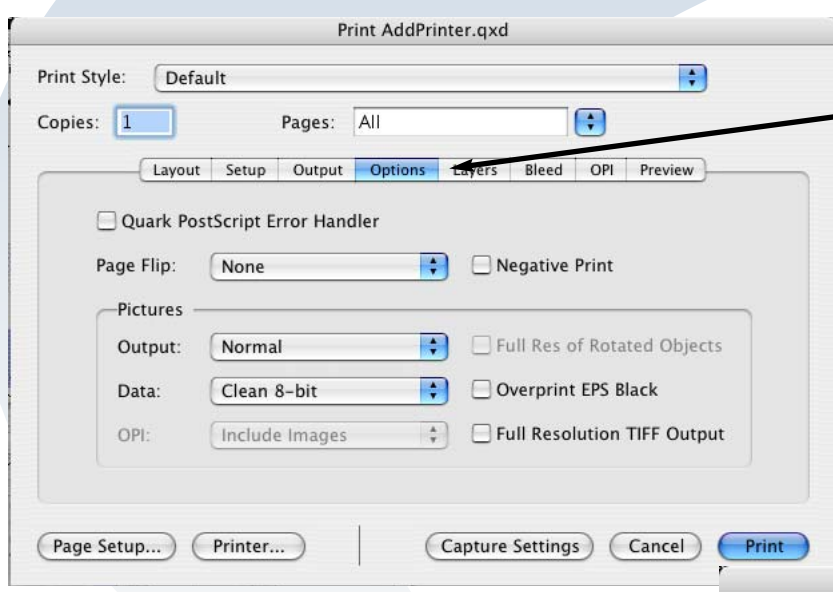


2. The "Setup" tab should look as follows. make sure you select the "Creo Refiner" in Printer Descriptions. Then set the rest of this tab for your job.

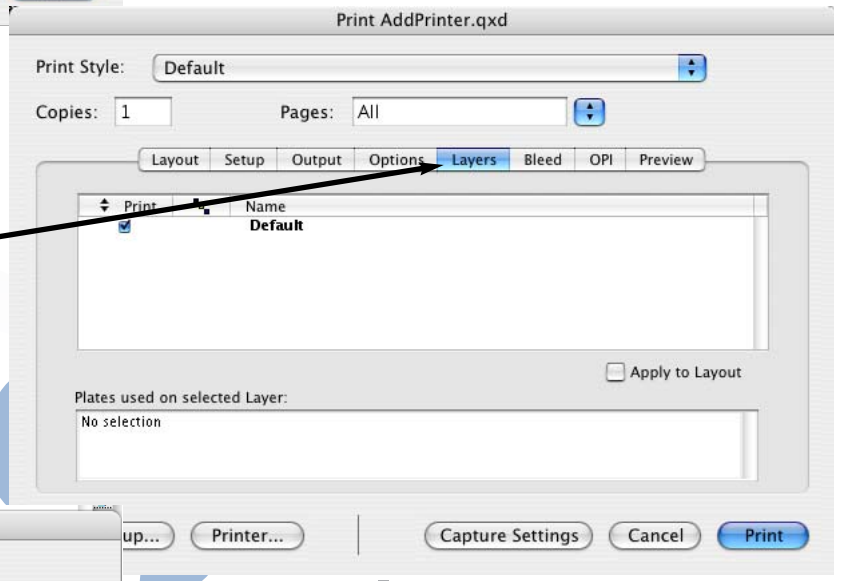


3. The "Output" tab should look as follows. Set this tab for your job, the key thing to point out here is the "Print Colors", make sure you have "Grayscale" or "Composite CMYK" ONLY checked. Then set the rest of this for your needs.

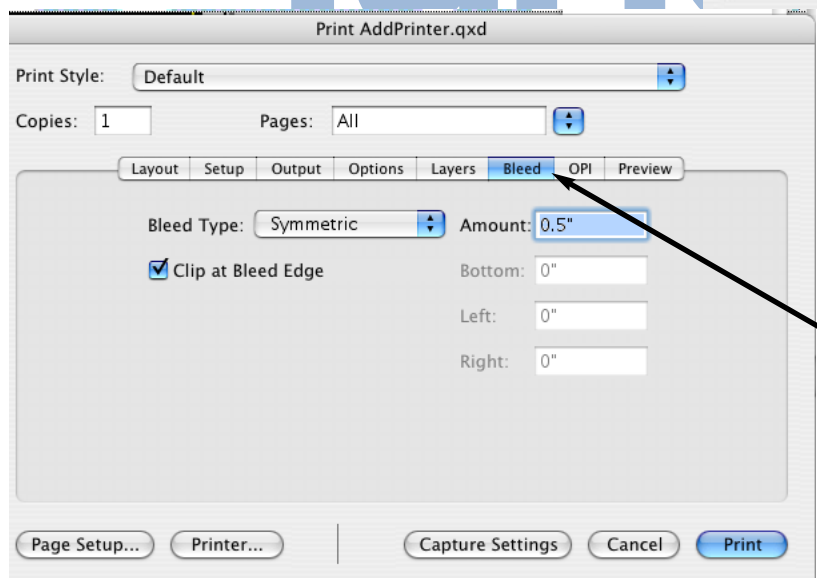




4. The "Options" tab should look as follows.



5. The "Layers" tab should look as follows.

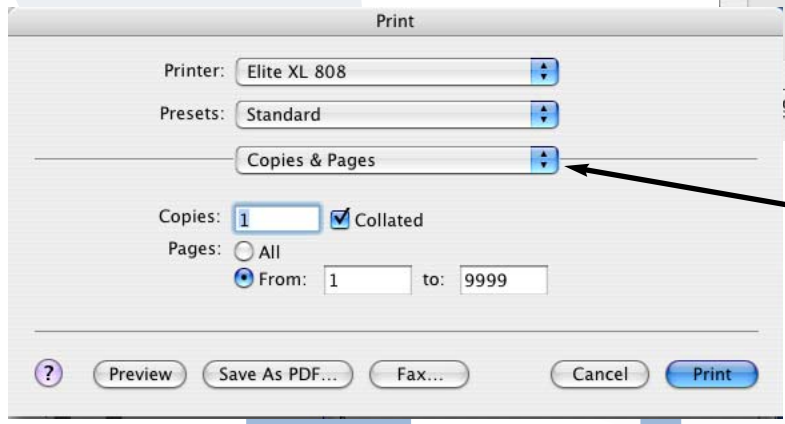
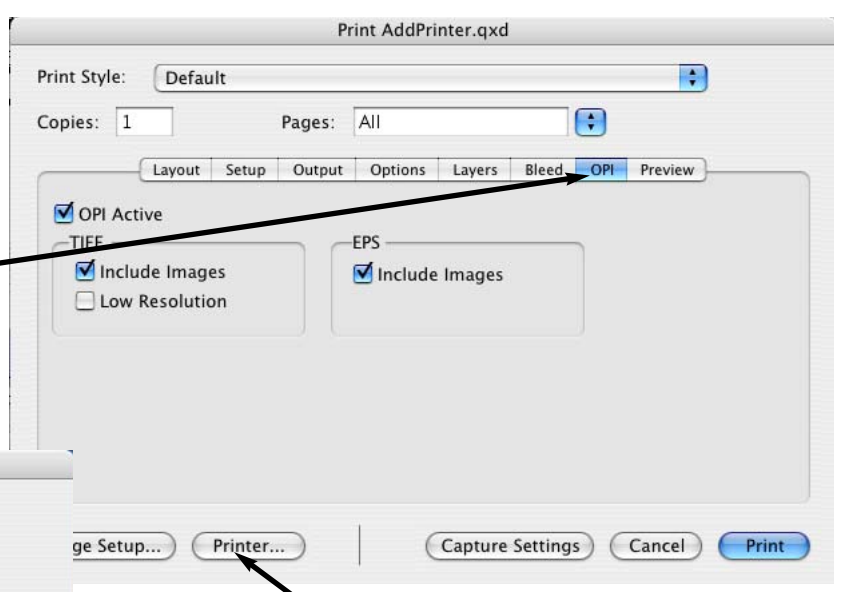


6. The "Bleed" tab should look as follows.

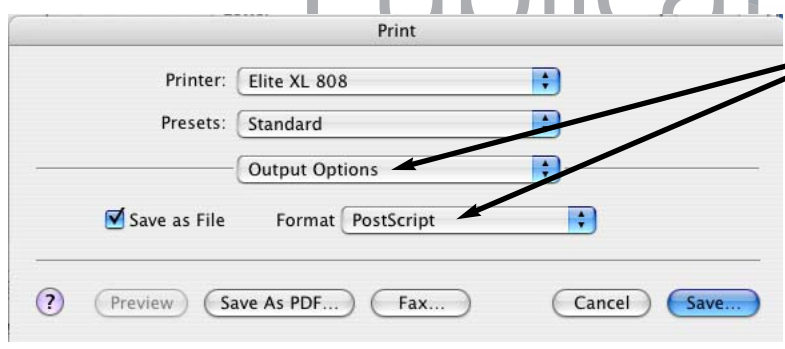

7. The "OPI" tab should look as follows.



9. Click on the "Printer" button and you will see another screen pop up. Click on "Copies & Pages" and scroll down to "Output".



10. in this "Output" screen, set it as follows, "Save as File" Format "Postscript"

11. click on "Save" Name the file and Save it on your Desktop then click on "Print" . A file with a ".ps" extension will show up on your Desktop.

12. With Distiller Launched and the default settings set to the Turley Settings, drag that file in the middle of the Distiller screen and let go. a PDF with then show up in the same location as the ".ps" file you just created.
