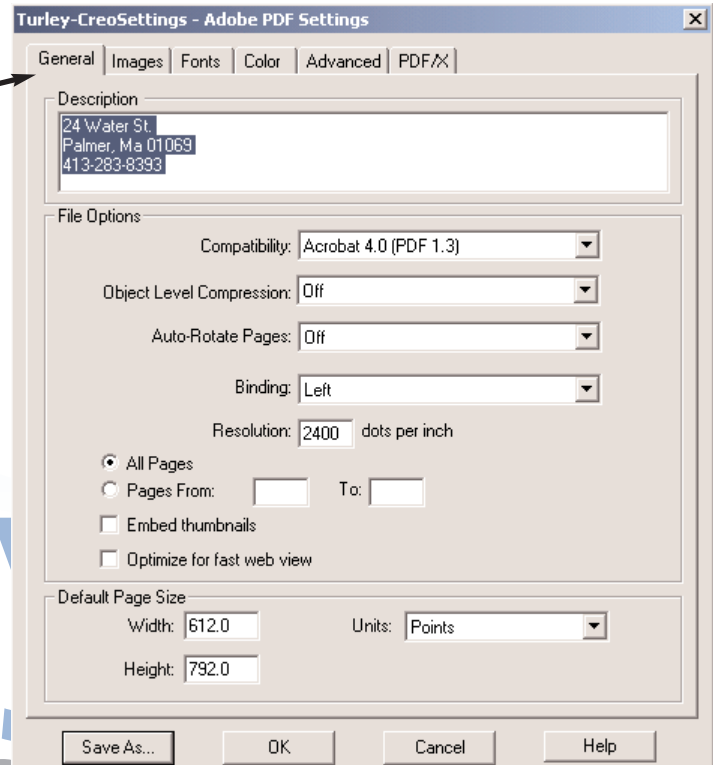
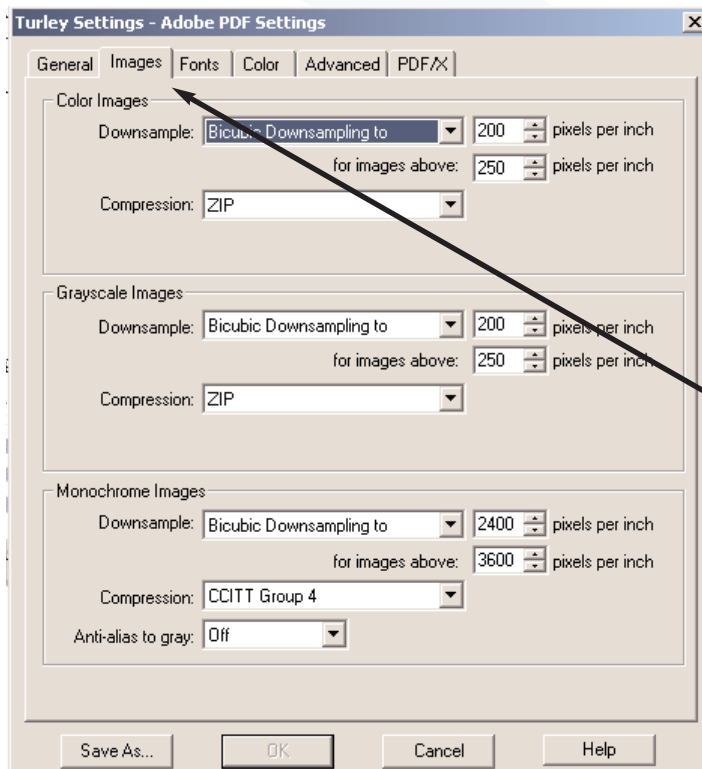


Configuring Acrobat Distiller 6 for Printable PDF's

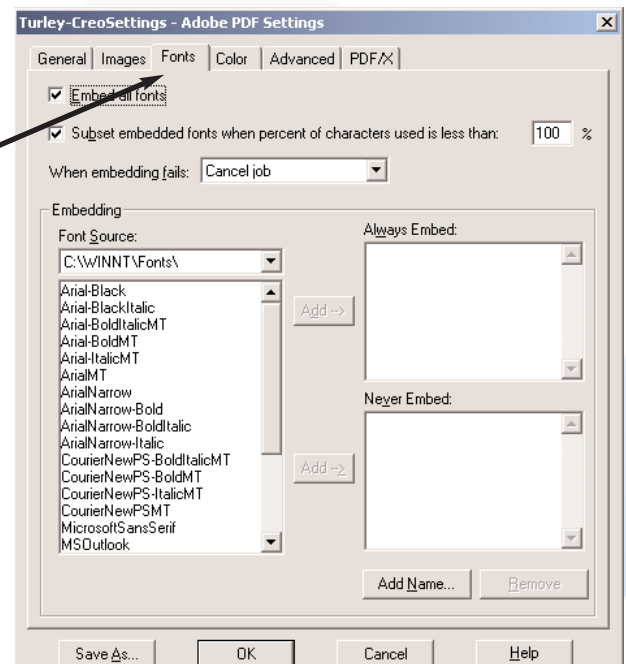
These directions will help you either to "Import" or "Configure" your Distiller to output a printable PDF. If you have the Turley Distiller settings, you can just add that to Distiller under "Settings". Navigate to the distiller file and add it. Default Settings should say now "Turley-CreoSettings".

If you don't have the file, you can simply follow this diagram and create your own and use that. Please follow the pictures as you see them.

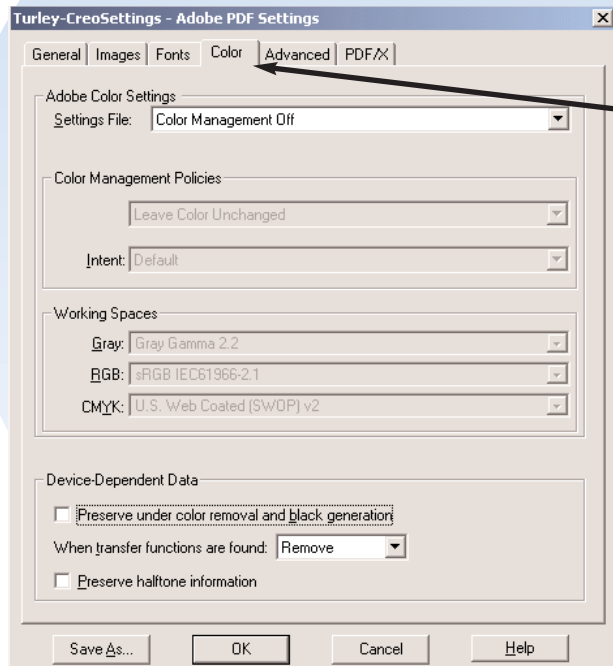
1. Launch Distiller 6 and click on "Settings" then "Edit Adobe PDF Settings". You will see the "General" tab with 4 or 5 more tabs behind it. Configure this page as you see it here.



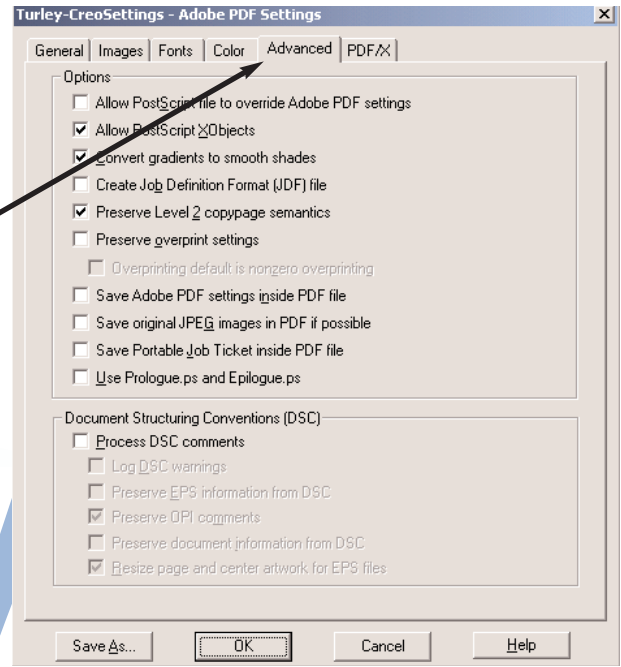
2. Next Click on "Images" tab and configure this page as you see it here.



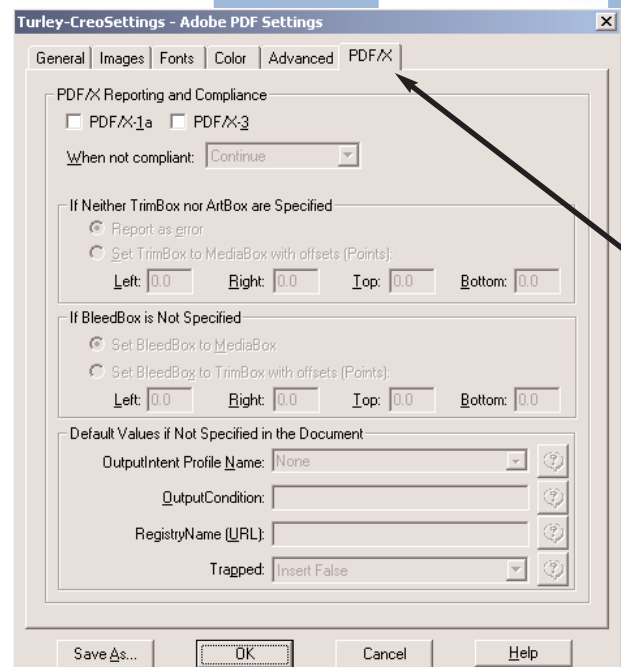
3. Next Click on "Fonts" Tab and configure this page as you see it here.



4. Next Click on **“Color”** Tab and configure this page as you see it here.



5. Next Click on **“Advanced”** Tab and configure this page as you see it here.



6. Next Click on **“PDF/X”** Tab (If you have Pro Version. Standard will not have this) and configure this page as you see it here.

7. Next Click on **“Save As”** at the bottom left and name it **“TurleySettings.joboptions”**. do not change the location of where it is saving the file. (Which usually is *“My Computer\c:\Documents and Settings\All Users\Documents\Adobe PDF 6.0\Settings”*)
